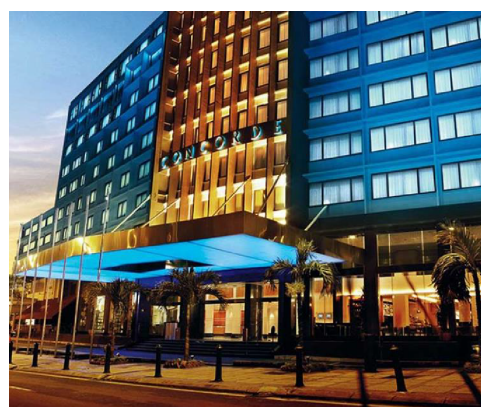

Accommodation

Participants are encouraged to stay at the meeting venue (Concorde Hotel KL) or nearby hotels within walking distance.

Recommended nearby hotels include:

- Shangri-La Kuala Lumpur (approximately 3 minutes walk)
- Renaissance Kuala Lumpur Hotel & Convention Centre (approximately 5 minutes walk)
- Four Points by Sheraton Kuala Lumpur Hotel (approximately 5 minutes walk)
- Hyatt Centric City Centre Kuala Lumpur (approximately 8 minutes walk)
- Hotel Maya Kuala Lumpur (approximately 10 minutes walk)



Special accommodation rates have been negotiated for participants at **Concorde Hotel Kuala Lumpur**. RESERVATION CONDITIONS

Online reservation to refer to online cancellation term.
- For reservations on guest's personal account, a credit card imprint will be secured upon arrival to facilitate check-out procedures and confirm the guest's status. In the event that no credit card is available, a nominal deposit equivalent to the hotel number of nights reserved will be collected from the guest (s).

Local Transportation

Kuala Lumpur has an extensive public transportation network.

Nearby stations include:

- Bukit Nanas Monorail Station (2 minutes walk)
- Dang Wangi LRT Station (5 minutes walk)
- Raja Chulan Monorail Station (10 minutes walk)

Grab is the most commonly used ride-hailing application.

Transportation from Airport (KLIA)

Concorde Hotel Kuala Lumpur is approximately 60 km from KLIA Terminals. There are many transportation options:

- ATMs and currency exchange services are available at KLIA Terminals, major shopping malls, and near the hotel.

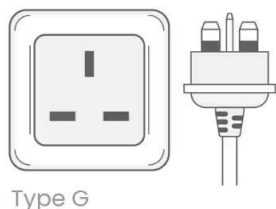
Language:

Electric sockets



Malaysia uses Type G power plugs and sockets. The standard voltage is 240 V. **Type G** is mainly used in the United Kingdom, Singapore, Ireland, Hong Kong, Brunei, Malta, Cyprus, and several Gulf countries. Participants from countries using different plug types are advised to bring a universal travel adapter.

Visa requirements
